Advanced Placement Program (AP)

If you have taken the CEEB advanced placement through your high school, you may be eligible for advanced placement and/or credit. Students should check with the transfer institution they plan to attend for transferability. Students must complete 12 credit hours at Cowley with a GPA of 2.00 or higher before AP credit is listed on the transcript. To request a copy of the grade report, write to the Advanced Placement Program, PO Box 6671, Princeton, New Jersey 08541-6671 or call 1-877-274-6477. The Cowley code is 6008. There is no charge for AP credit. A maximum of 15 credit hours can be awarded for Advance Placement. Credits by exam listed on transcripts from other colleges are not automatically awarded credit. Scores must be officially sent to Cowley College from College Board. See below for equivalencies.

Students must complete 12 credit hours at Cowley with a GPA of 2.00 or higher before CLEP credit is listed on the transcript. A maximum of 15 credit hours can be awarded for CLEP examinations. Credits by exam listed on transcripts from other colleges are not automatically awarded credit.
