Automotive technicians may begin their careers in dealerships, independent shops, and specialized industry positions, with continually expanding advancement opportunities.

The two-year associate of applied science degree, which is certified by the NATEF (National Automotive Technicians Educational Foundation), concentrates on a theoretical background in diagnosis, electrical/electronic and hydraulic systems, automatic & manual transmissions, engine performance, heating & air conditioning, brakes, suspension & steering and engine repair. Students work on developing the skills needed to advance to a supervisory position, including customer relations, estimating materials and labor costs, and managing the work of others.
