a. Pre-Professional Skills Test (PPST)

- Writing Score of 172 or higher
- Reading Score of 173 or higher
- Mathematics Score of 172 or higher

(Elementary/Early Childhood majors also need: CBASE score -235 in Science and Social Studies)

b. ACT - 22 in each subtest measuring Reading, English, and Mathematics

(Elementary/Early Childhood majors also need: CBASE score -235 in Science and Social Studies)

c. College Assessment of Academic Proficiency (CAAP)

- Writing Score of 55
- Reading Score of 56
- Mathematics Score of 53

(Elementary/Early Childhood majors also need: CBASE score -235 in Science and Social Studies)

d. College BASE Test (CBASE) with a passing score of 235 (minimum) in English, Reading/Writing, and Mathematics
