

## **Cowley College Dual Enrolled High School Students Admissions and Assessment Guidelines**

Program admissions requirement: A permission form signed by parents, the principal, and the counselor is required each academic semester.

General Education/Transfer Pathways: High School Seniors, Juniors, Sophomores, or a 'gifted' Freshman

• HS GPA of 2.75 or higher with College Level Reading assessment of 18 ACT in Reading or NexGen Accuplacer of 255 or higher or meet course placement guidelines using high school criteria listed below

OR

• HS GPA of 3.0 on pre-college curriculum (will not require reading assessment)

<u>Career & Technical Education Programs:</u> High School Seniors, Juniors, Sophomores (most programs have selective admittance)

• GPA of 2.0 or higher, College Level Reading assessment of NexGen Accuplacer of 224
