The International Baccalaureate subject tests are one way to earn college credit by examination. These exams are given in high schools that have the International Baccalaureate program. If you've taken International Baccalaureate high school courses, you may be able to receive college credit.

Students who have completed any of the following IB tests should have International Baccalaureate forward an official report of their scores to the Cowley College Registrar's office in order to receive credit.
