# **DAY TRIPS**

# Trip 1: Broadway's Wicked in OKC Thursday, February 22nd in Oklahoma City, OK

The musical *Wicked* tells the backstory of the Wicked Witch of the West and the Good Witch of the North from *The Wizard of Oz*. Taking place before Dorothy arrives, it follows the unlikely bond between two young witches, Elphaba and Glinda, and explains how they respectively became the Wicked Witch and the Good Witch. The show, packed with special effects and memorable songs, has been a cultural phenomenon for 20 years on Broadway. This trip, which includes lunch and a matinee of the show, costs \$95 and has a tentative time frame of 10:45am to 9:00pm.



## **Trip 2: Underground Bound**

#### Wednesday, March 20th in Hutchinson, KS


We are bound for underground. First, we're off to Strataca, a salt museum 650 feet underground and built in the heart of one of the biggest rock salt deposits in the world. Our theme continues as we head to a vermicompost farm: Fed N Happy. This earthworm farm is over 100,000 sq. ft. and spread across three states. We'll visit their Hutch location for a tour to learn how these tiny alchemists fertilize and supercharge soil for growing. The tentative time frame of this trip is 7:45am to 6:30pm. Lunch is included, and the cost is \$50.



# Trip 3: Mystery Trip

#### Wednesday, April 3rd / Location Unknown (to you)

A show? A museum? Something else entirely? Our destination is top secret, kept under lock and key. The Golden Tigers may or may not have been there before. The only hint is that we won't travel further than three hours of driving time in one direction. If you are up for an adventure, like surprises, and are flexible, this is the trip for you. The only rule: you get what you get, and you don't throw a fit. We'll leave at approximately 8am and return to Cowley College around 6:00pm. Lunch is included, and the cost of the trip is \$50.



# Trip 4: All Aboard Concordia! Friday, April 19th in Concordia, KS

From 1854-1929, the Orphan Train Movement transported orphaned and abandoned children from the East Coast to the 48 continental states. This trip to Concordia will take us to the National Orphan Train Complex to learn the history of this movement. It is estimated that 1 in 25 people know an orphan train rider. Cloud County has a rich history though so in addition to learning about this fascinating piece of US history, we'll also tour the restored Brown Grand Opera House Theatre and visit the Nazareth Motherhouse. This gorgeous five story brick



convent is the home of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Concordia, KS. It will be a day filled with vibrant history and magnificent architecture. This trip is a repeat of the Concordia visit in Spring 2023. We will depart at 7am and return to Cowley College around 6:30pm. The cost of the trip is \$45, and our catered lunch is included.

You bring the problem, question, or tech challenge, and a digital skills coach will help you find an answer.


