## **REGISTRATION PROCESS**

### **HOMECOMING SWEEPSTAKES TROPHY COMPETITION**

Our Annual Homecoming Sweepstakes-it is now a tradition by the Office of Student Life that will become a staple of the college. Any group submitting entry forms for ALL Homecoming activities designated below will be able to compete for the Homecoming Sweepstakes Trophy. Groups will place 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, or 4<sup>th</sup> places and will win the following prizes in the Sweepstakes Trophy competition:

1<sup>st</sup> Place: \$100 and the Sweepstakes Trophy (This trophy will stay in the Student Life office case).

2<sup>nd</sup> Place: \$75

3<sup>rd</sup> Place: \$50

4<sup>th</sup> Place: \$25

## **SWEEPSTAKES ENTRIES**

If a group wishes to not enter all activities, but a select few, the group will still be allowed to compete in the Homecoming Activities. Only one event is required and that is the Banner Contest. However, groups are encouraged to participate in all Homecoming activities. If a group is not competing for the Sweepstakes Trophy Competition, groups must still register for each activity they wish to participate in.

## **PARTICIPANT ELIGIBILITY**

Any groups where all members are currently enrolled at Cowley are eligible to participate in Homecoming events. Groups do not need to be registered student organizations to participate. For example, residence hall floors, ministry groups, sports teams, etc. are considered non-registered groups.

## **FUNDING**

Student Life provides funds for certain events for any organization/group that signs up for Homecoming Sweepstakes. This includes the Iron Chef Competition and the sheet for the banner contest. Noncompliance will result in no funding in future events. Money for the Iron Chef can be picked up on Monday, January 25<sup>th</sup> from Kristi in the Student Life Office.

*Note: In case two groups tie for a place, for example, 2nd, the points for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places will be added together and divided between the two groups.*

## Tiger Spirit Banner Decorating Contest

**EVENT DESCRIPTION:** The Spirit Banner decorating contest is a sign that is decorated to support Cowley College, your organization and the homecoming theme “Cowley Thru the Decades.

” All Participants are required to do the Spirit Banner contest. The Banner will be displayed during the halftime of coronation.

**DATE:** ***PICK UP SHEET/BANNER during the time frame of January 25th – January 29th***—from Kristi in SL Office.

**Monday, February 8th** the Banners must be completed and brought back to the Student Life Office by 4:30 pm. Judging will take place at 9:00 am, February 10<sup>th</sup>.

### **REQUIREMENT\$:** Banner--

1. The banners must be completed by 4:30pm Monday, February 8<sup>th</sup>.
2. The Spirit Banner must support the homecoming theme.
3. All Spirit Banners will be displayed during the Homecoming games.

**MATERIAL\$:** A sheet will be provided to each group to use their creative minds to showcase their talents.

**DISQUALIFICATION\$:** Banners will be disqualified for each of the following reasons:

1. Profanity.
2. Use of any design that is racially, sexually, religiously, or otherwise offensive as determined by the contest judges.

**SUGGESTIONS:** Please plan ahead- The banners will be on display during the homecoming game. Alumni, parents and families will be present.

**JUDGING:** Judges for the Spirit Banner Contest will be looking at each entry for the following qualities rates in a scale of 1 to 10 for each category.

<b>Color/creativity</b>	<b>10 points</b>
<b>Use of the Homecoming theme</b>	<b>10 points</b>

**SWEEPSTAKES SCORING:** Total points received by each group in Spirit Banners on the above basis will be awarded with the below designated sweepstakes points:

1<sup>st</sup> place: 100 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place: 75 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place: 50 points, 4<sup>th</sup> place: 25 points, All others: 10 points

# TIGER IRON CHEF

## **EVENT DESCRIPTION:**

The Iron Chef Competition is a homecoming battle that challenges each team to use their creativeness to come up with the most unique and delicious dish. Each organization will be judged on their creativeness and presentation of any kind of dish of their choice, but they must incorporate one secret ingredient that will be announced by the CCSS executive team on the Facebook page.

## **IMPORTANT DATES:**

Organizations are to be in Tiger Deli with dish display ready by **NOON**, Wednesday, February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2016 in The Tiger Deli at 12:15 the judging begins.

## **MATERIALS:**

The ***secret ingredient*** will be announced on Monday January 25<sup>th</sup> at 3pm– Ingredient will be taped up on Kristi Shaw's Door–(Student Life Director, Jungle) Room. A list must be provided of the ingredients your group wishes to use which is to be turned in with this application. A maximum of \$15 dollars will be given to each group. Any further ingredients may be bought by the group with no reimbursement. A receipt must be returned with the envelope/money provided for your group. Disqualification if no receipt is given back. Sponsor/Coach will be responsible if this is NOT done correctly.

## **REQUIREMENTS:**

1. The dish may not be store-bought, but store-bought ingredients can be modified to fit the recipe
2. Only one portion of your dish will be tasted by each judge plan for five (5) judges.
3. Any participants handling food must wear gloves.
4. The dishes should also be able to be sampled by anyone at the event interested in trying your creation/recipe after judging.
5. **A recipe card must be provided at your table for the judges/students to view.**

## **DISQUALIFICATION:**

Teams may be disqualified from the competition for the following reasons:

1. The entry is determined un-edible.
2. The dish does not have the secret ingredient.

## **JUDGING:**

Judges for the Tiger Top Chef contest will be looking at each entry for the following qualities rates in a scale of 1 to 10 for each category.

# **Cowley Jeopardy & Battle of the Decades: Minute to Win It**

- EVENT DESCRIPTION:** A Jeopardy based game of trivia about the decades, movies, and Cowley College.
- EVENT RULES:** Teams/clubs shall be at their assigned stations and shall answer all questions at their station. If a member leaves for any reason he or she will be allowed to continue the game but not allowed to answer the question that he or she left on. To answer a question a team member will raise his or her hand in order to be recognized unless buzzers are present in which case the team will use the buzzer to answer the questions. Judges shall be present in order to determine who has raised his or her hand first. In the event of a tie a coin toss shall determine which team shall answer, if the winning team misses the question then the second team shall be able to answer next. All question will be open until a correct response is given, all groups have answered, or no one answers after 10 seconds after the previous incorrect answer. During the game random bonus Cowley questions shall be asked.
- DATE:** Monday February 1<sup>st</sup> 2016 at 7 PM-9PM –in conjunction with Minute to Win It
- LOCATION:** Wright Room.
- MATERIALS:** A table and a team/club label/sign displaying which team/club is being represented shall be provided in the day of the event
- DISQUALIFICATION:** Teams/Clubs shall be disqualified for each of the following reasons:
1. Profanity.
  2. Use of any language that is racially, sexually, religiously, or otherwise offensive as determined by the contest judges.
  3. Using any device to look up the answers by anyone on a team or anyone in the room to assist a team.
- JUDGING:** Judges for the Cowley Jeopardy game will be in control of the game and shall determine if answers are correct and which group was first to respond.
- SWEEPSTAKES SCORING:** Total points received by each group in Cowley Jeopardy on the above basis will be awarded with the below designated sweepstakes points:

## **Battle of the Decades: Minute to Win It**

- EVENT DESCRIPTION:** Each group will represent their decade through costumes as they battle for the Minute to Win it Battle.
- EVENT RULES:** Teams/clubs will form 4 person teams to compete in the Battle of the Decades. Each team will be given 60 seconds to complete each task The team to finish first will receive the points for that round. At the end of the Battle, each group will receive the amount of points their team has won throughout the battle as well as extra points for winning 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup>.
- DATE:** February 1st, 2016 at 7 PM-9PM In conjunction with Cowley Jeopardy
- LOCATION:** Wright Room
- MATERIALS:** Materials for each task will be provided when the round is announced.
- DISQUALIFICATIONS:** Teams/Clubs shall be disqualified for each of the following reasons:
1. Profanity.
  2. Use of any language that is racially, sexually, religiously, or otherwise offensive as determined by the contest judges.
- JUDGING:** Judges for the Battle of the decades will be in control of the rounds and will determine which teams finished each task first. They will also be in charge of keeping time and scores.
- SWEEPSTAKES SCORING:** Total points received by each group in the Battle of the Decades on the above basis will be awarded with the below designated sweepstakes points:

1<sup>st</sup> place-----100 POINTS  
2<sup>ND</sup> place-----75 POINTS  
3<sup>RD</sup> place-----50 POINTS  
4<sup>TH</sup> place-----25 POINTS  
All others-----10 POINTS
