


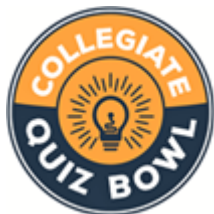
Good day Tigers!
