Attending: Roy Reynolds, Lea Newman, Kristi Shaw, Shane Larson, Landon West, Jason O'Toole

Approval of minutes: Minutes of the 02/17/2016 meeting were approved as submitted.

Update on AlcoholEdu – Jason reports that the College has concluded favorable negotiations with the vendor of AlcoholEdu and Haven, and has secured a three-year extension to the current subscription. The plan is to introduce students to AlcoholEdu and Haven in orientation, and to require completion of both courses before the beginning of First Year Experience during the Fall, 2016 semester. Jason spoke on the need to market these courses, and to include the Mulvane and Wichita students in these efforts, thereby making alcohol prevention and sexual harassment/assault prevention part of the Cowley College culture. Jason also mentioned that there is the possibility of a larger dormitory population next academic year. Finally, Jason indicated that another round of employee Haven training, plus Title IX training, is approaching. There was discussion of making use of AlcoholEdu features such as those for sanctions and for parents.

Area Updates:

Landon provided the following summary of the housing department's involvement in alcohol and drug related incidents since the time of our last meeting:

- 2/17 – 2 alcohol violations
- 4/2 – Drug Violation – Cowley Parking lot – 2 students cited by ACPD.
- 4/6 – Drug Violation – out of town – Cowley Student
- 4/11 – 1 alcohol violation
- 4/21 – 1 alcohol violation
- 4/28 – 2 alcohol violations
- 4/29 – 2 alcohol violations

Landon reports that the alcohol violations listed above consisted of open/empty alcohol containers in student possession, not active consumption; ACPD were not contacted.

Shane reports that, in the athletics department, it has been a quiet spring semester. There have been no positive drug screens for the year.

Kristi reported on end of year activities, including the End of the Year Bash, massages, and the late night breakfast. Orientation groups begin 06/01/2016. Kristi indicates that student leadership is looking good for next academic year.

Lea reports that CAAT is wrapping up activities for the year, including planning next year's monthly awareness calendar.

Jason reports that the position of Student Life Counselor has been advertised, and that recruitment will also include direct mailings to Behavioral Sciences Regulatory Board licensees.

Roy reminded the team that the Biennial Review is due during the Fall, 2016 semester. This being his final meeting as a member of the team, Roy thanked all members present and past for their involvement in institutional prevention efforts in the time that he has served as chair. Roy wished the team good luck in their future efforts.
